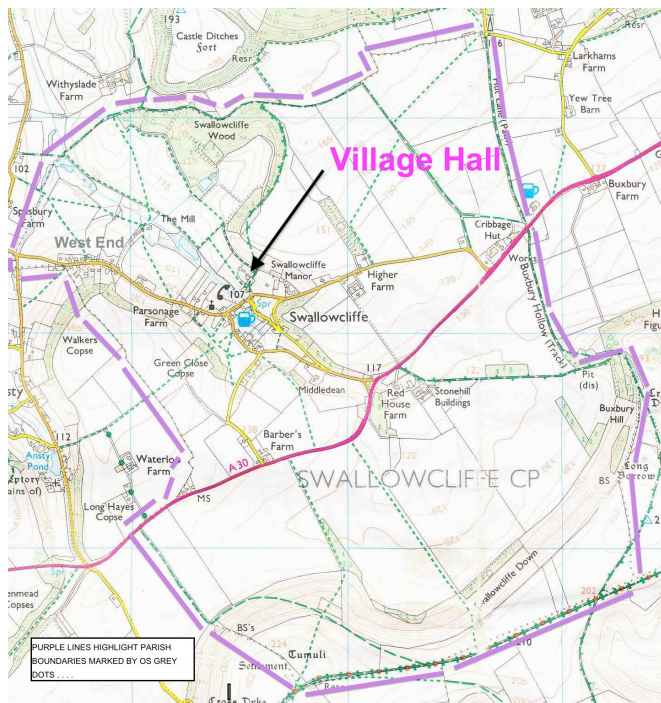
ABOUT SWALLOWCLIFFE

Swallowcliffe. - most recently winner of the Wessex Water “Best Hamlet” in Wiltshire” award, 2020, has quite a history

Swallowcliffe, as an agricultural community, can trace its history back to the Saxon Swealawanclyf Charter in 940AD. Over the last 100 years, Swallowcliffe has experienced great social change, leaving far fewer people employed on the land. Today the Parish has some 87 homes and around 180 residents.

Swallowcliffe has a vibrant community with numerous events and activities. These include a biennial Village Fete, regular Christmas events such as the candlelit carol service, and Christmas dinner. There are regular quiz and curry nights in the Village Hall and the Royal Oak.
